Illinois Attorney General Lisa Madigan Accepts Award from DuPage Mayors and Managers Conference

Illinois Attorney General Lisa Madigan was presented with the DuPage Mayors and Managers Conference 2007 Governmental Leader of the Year Award at the February 20 meeting in Lombard, Illinois. This award is given annually to elected or appointed officials who support initiatives important to DuPage municipalities.

Attorney General Madigan was nominated by Conference members for her tireless efforts during negotiations on the Cable and Video Competition Act and her work on behalf of municipalities in other areas such as reducing access to ingredients for producing methamphetamine, providing training for police to understand websites targeting children, and helping to negotiate electric rate relief.
