

BUS RAPID TRANSIT

Bus Rapid Transit is an emerging technology in the public transportation field, and it has been used successfully in several other parts of the United States as a less expensive, but still high-quality alternative to rail.

The proposed Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) service, also known as the DuPage J-Line, would connect a planned transportation center at 95th Street on Metra's proposed STAR line, downtown Naperville and Oak Brook to O'Hare or the Northwest Transportation Center in Schaumburg. In the near term, it can start as an express bus, running several times per day.
